BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE

Stewart Rafert is a graduate of Earlham College, and received a Ph.D. from the University of Delaware in 1982. He is also the first recipient of a graduate fellowship for studies in Midwestern history from the Indiana Historical Society. He has worked for the Indiana Miami tribe in its bid for federal recognition and teaches at the University of Delaware and Wilmington Friends School.
